Step 2 Custom a Sample

> Option 1 Get a sample without Making a Model

If you want to custom a sample without making a model, it costs \$50 for File Revision+ Laser Cutting+ International Shipping. We will revise your design file to meet laser-cut standard and send the e-proof for approval. The time varies according to how easily the artwork can be revised. After e-proof approved, it takes 10-12 working days for you to receive the sample.

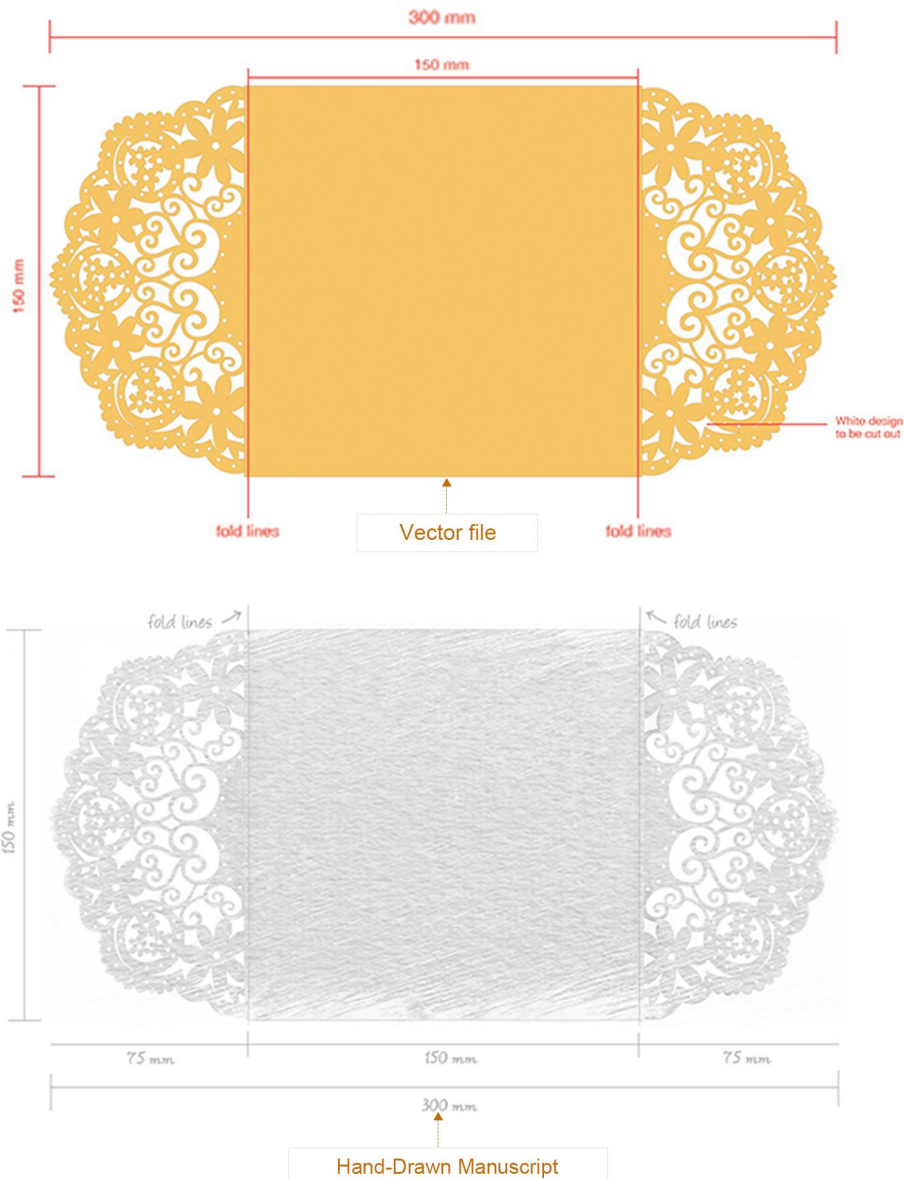

Laser-cut Design Requirements

- If you know how to use a vector graphics editor, or you have a hand-drawn manuscript, check the sketch below.





After laser cutting, it comes out to be like this

Laser-cut design requirements:

1. Please provide flat unfolded drawing in JPG/PDF file, marking the folded line. A perspective effect drawing should be provided for a complex design.
2. Please provide dimension. The dimension should be drawn as per 1:1 (Resolution > 100).
3. There should be no pattern existing in the pattern to be laser cut.
For example, the below pattern in blue is to be laser cut. The white pattern inside the blue one in the left picture actually won't exist after laser cutting. It will just turn out to be as the right picture.



4. The width of pattern to be laser cut should be $\geq 1\text{mm}$.
The space among laser cut patterns should also be $\geq 1\text{mm}$.
5. The pattern line should be clear. Please leave the laser cut parts to be blank and fill the other parts on the invitation with a color, so that we can check the design better.
